

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Warner, Moss, Schuleit, and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic; City Engineer Hinken; and Clerk-Treasurer Rasmussen.

Absent: None.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the special City Council meeting held April 11, 2017.
2. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held April 18, 2017.
3. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period April 7, 2017 in the amount of \$117,543.21. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending April 11, 2017 in the amount of \$235,324.70.
4. Approval of minutes for the regular Planning Commission meeting held April 13, 2017.
5. Set a public hearing for Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall to receive comment on a recommendation from the Planning Commission to vacate a portion of Marvel Drive.

Council held a public hearing to receive comment on an amendment to the Utilities Ordinance.

Mayor Hoppough opened the public hearing at 7:35 p.m.

Todd Taylor of 925 Marvel Drive, owner of former country club property, gave support for the amendment to the ordinance.

After receiving no further comments, Mayor Hoppough closed the public hearing at 7:37 p.m.

Council held a public hearing to receive comment on a proposed ordinance to vacate a portion of Coffren Avenue as presented.

Council considered an amendment to the Utilities Ordinance.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed ordinance no. 17-02, and ordinance regarding sanitary facilities; mandatory connection as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a recommendation from the Planning Commission on an ordinance to vacate a portion of Coffren Street.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the recommendation from the Planning Commission to adopt the proposed ordinance No. 17-03, an ordinance to vacate a portion of Coffren Avenue Right-Of-Way as presented. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of Traffic Control Order No. 2017-03, to establish yield signs at Clark Court and Grosvenor Drive and at Meyer Court at Grosvenor Drive.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed Traffic Control Order No. 2017-03 establishing YIELD signs on Meyer Court and Clark Court at Grosvenor Drive as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.
