

The special meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex, 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, MI 48838 at 6:21 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Scoby, Moss, Cunliffe, Lehman, Schuleit, and Warner; City Manager Bosanic; City Engineer Hinken; and Clerk-Treasurer Rasmussen.

Councilperson Schuleit disclosed that she is a member of the Board of Trustees for Spectrum Health United Hospital.

Council considered the award of a bid for construction of a City street bids were received to construct the proposed relocation of Marvel Drive. Four were received. The low bidder was Kamminga & Roodvoets, Inc.(K&R) of Grand Rapids.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To award the bid for the construction of Marvel Drive Relocation to K&R in the amount not-to-exceed of \$214,572.94, subject to appropriate approvals and assurances from Spectrum Health United Hospital. Also as subject to approval from City Council for land transfer and vacating street. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The special meeting was held to review the proposed Capital Improvement Projects Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
