Councilperson Warner MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered approving an increase the current water rates by five percent (5%) as presented.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of new fire hose for the Public Safety Department to Emergency Vehicle Services Inc. of Greenville, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$2,850.00 as presented. Councilperson Lehman seconded. Unanimously adopted.
