

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Cunliffe, Warner, Moss, and Schuleit; City Manager Bosanic, Acting Public Safety Director Magirl, and Clerk-Treasurer Rasmussen.

Absent: None.

The Statement of Citizens consisted of the following: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held August 1, 2017.
2. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period July 14, 2017 in the amount of \$114,174.87. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending August 09, 2017 in the amount of \$311,000.73.
3. Approval of the June Financial Report.
4. Approval of the 2016-2017 Budget Amendment.

Council considered the appointment of a candidate for the vacancy on City Council.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To appoint Jay Linton to fill the seat on City Council vacated by Lloyd Scoby. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the award of a bid for the purchase of a public safety cruiser for the Public Safety Department.

Councilperson Warner MOVED: To award a bid for the purchase of a 2017 Ford Interceptor to Ed Kohen Ford of Greenville, Michigan in the amount not to exceed \$28,293.82. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered an ordinance to vacate existing Marvel Drive.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve the proposed Ordinance No. 17-04, an ordinance vacating a portion of Marvel Drive as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a Proposed Traffic Control Order 2017-05 for relocated Marvel Drive.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: To approve Traffic Control Order No. 2017-05 directing that the relocated Marvel Drive (subject to renaming) include a STOP sign at Oak Street, yielding the right of way to Oak Street traffic and a STOP sign at Judd Street, yielding the right of way to Judd Street traffic. In addition, Traffic Control Order No. 2017-05 shall also direct that the entire relocated Marvel Drive (subject to renaming) shall prohibit parking on both sides of the street and be signed accordingly as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered a motion to enter into executive session to discuss the purchase of real property.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: To enter into executive session to discuss the purchase of real property. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council Members entered into executive session at 8:21pm.
