

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Hoppough, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

Present: Mayor Hoppough; Councilpersons Lehman, Warner, Moss, Linton, Cunliffe, and Schuleit; City Manager Bosanic, and Deputy Clerk Grace-Hatfield.

The Statement of Citizens consisted of the following: None.

Councilperson Lehman MOVED: The Consent Agenda be approved as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

The Consent Agenda consisted of the following:

1. Approval of minutes for the regular City Council meeting held September 5, 2017.
2. Approval of payroll reports for regular pay period ending August 25, 2017 in the amount of \$121,683.63. Approval of accounts payable report for pay period ending September 1, 2017 in the amount of \$179,841.38.
3. Approval of the minutes for the regular Downtown Development Authority meeting held August 8, 2017.
4. To set a Public Hearing for October 3, 2017 at 7:30pm at City Hall to receive comment on an amendment to the Hawkers and Peddlers Ordinance.

Council considered the request for street closures in connection with the annual M1063 WGLM Halloween Bash.

Councilperson Schuleit MOVED: To approve the proposed closure of Cass Street from Lafayette Street east to the alley way from 2pm to 6pm on October 31, 2017 as presented. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Council considered the approval of a proposed contract for funding with the Michigan Department of Transportation in connection with the transit facility replacement project.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed Project Authorization grant contract No. 2017-0057 in the amount of \$85,000 for the proposed Transit

Replacement project as presented. Councilperson Schuleit seconded. Motion carried by a vote of six ayes and one nay.

Council considered the approval of closing certain streets in connection with the Annual Christmas Parade.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the closure of certain streets for the Annual Christmas Parade Friday, December 1, 2017 from 5pm to 6:30pm as follows:

- o Lafayette Street from Washington Street to Gibson Street
- o Clay Street from Grove Street to South Drive at City Lot 5
- o Cass Street from Lafayette Street to Clay Street
- o Grove Street at Lafayette Street intersection
- o Montcalm Street at Lafayette Street intersection
- o State Street from Lafayette Street to Clay Street

Councilperson Warner seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.
